Educational resources on 2SLGBTQIA+ inclusion

Members of the 2SLGBTQIA+ communities are integral to the fabric of our workplaces, schools, families, and movements for justice. Although progress has been made toward greater visibility and rights for the broader 2SLGBTQIA+ community in Canada, there are still many individuals with overlapping marginalized identities that continue to face systemic barriers, discrimination, and exclusion. With this in mind, it is important that inclusion go beyond symbolic gestures.

Inclusion is not a one-time initiative or a single moment during Pride Season, it is an ongoing process that should be rooted in action and accountability which requires reflection, learning, and meaningful change. Whether you are just beginning this journey or deepening your commitment, we hope this guide offers tools, insights, and inspiration to take intentional next steps in advancing 2SLGBTQIA+ inclusion.

This guide is designed to support individuals and organizations in building inclusive environments where 2SLGBTQIA+ people feel safe, respected, and affirmed all year long. Rather than centering anti-2SLGBTQIA+ rhetoric, we have focused on the strength and leadership found within these communities, and the ways we can all play a role in fostering spaces that celebrate diversity and inclusion.

To begin this guide, we want to start by highlighting a few organizations who are actively working to support 2SLGBTQIA+ communities through education, advocacy, direct support, and movement building:
